

**Welcome to the Furnace, our 24/7 prayer room.**

**Take a deep breath. Relax.**

**This room is designed to be an intimate place for you to meet with the Lord.**

**While we have provided you with several stations to help you connect with God, there is no right or wrong way to do this.**

**Feel free to arrange things as you like and take part in the things that seem to stir your heart.**

**Enjoy this hour!**

**Having said that, there are a few guidelines:**

- \*\* *People taking shifts between 11pm and 7am must be 18 or older, or have written parental permission.*
- \*\* *Someone from our leadership team will be in the church throughout the night.*
- \*\* *Shifts are taken one person at a time.*
- \*\* *You will need to be at the church at least 10 minutes before your shift begins.*
- \*\* *Please please please please please **do not be late.** Please.*
- \*\* *If you encounter a problem, please seek out the staff member in the building or contact the “On Call” person whose name and number is posted on the On Call board located directly outside of the prayer room.*

### **Prayer Rock Station:**

Take a rock out of the bucket and write the name of a friend or family member who doesn't know the Lord. Then, place the rock on the table. Now pick up a different rock and pray for the people whose names are on it. Let's watch as the Lord changes some lives!

### **Map Station:**

Take a numbered pushpin and mark the place you desire to pray for. Write that number and what you are praying for on the brown paper area surrounding the map.

#### *Pray for:*

Our church, other churches, your neighborhood, schools, etc. Ask the Lord to reveal to us what the needs of the community are, and to bring revival to Long Island.

### **Prayer Graffiti Wall:**

Use this space to communicate whatever you wish to God. You can write a prayer, a scripture verse, a song lyric, or draw a picture.

### **Cross Station:**

Take a few moments and reflect upon the cross and Jesus' great sacrifice for us. Look in the mirror and spend some time in self-examination and confess to the Lord.

### **Table & Chair:**

A simple place to sit quietly and pray through the list. Or, write your prayers to God. Read your Bible and pray "Speak Lord, your servant is listening." Or just be still and know that He is God.

### **CD Player:**

Spend some time worshiping God through the music. Sing the lyrics as a prayer to God or just let them impact your soul. Or, just use the music as a background track as you visit the other stations.

### **Thanks & Praise Posters:**

It's important that we take time to praise God for who He is as well as what He has done. Write something that you praise God for as well as something you are thankful for.

### **The Wailing Wall:**

Take a post-it note and offer a short prayer regarding something you are burdened with. Let your heart cry out to God. Place the post-it in a square on the Wailing Wall. Take some time to pray for the burdens of others.
